Maverick owns 100 acres of vines in four sites across the Barossa Valley and Eden Valley. With the exception of the Trial Hill Riesling, which is already performing at a very high level, the wines are polished and handsomely oaked, but appear to have been harvested beyond the point of maximum freshness. The 2009 Shiraz is a pleasing improvement over the two previous vintages, but still retains some ultra-ripe character.



Long, elegant and stylish, this tangy, crystal-clear riesling has a penetrative, floral bouquet of lime juice and lemon zest backed by smoky, mineral nuances and a hint of slate. It's lean and steely, taut and streamlined, packing a fresh, juicy core of fruit with a chalky undercarriage, finishing crackly and crunchy, with a hint of pulpiness.
