Maverick Wines are made in major part from fruit biodynamically/organically grown from our unique owned vineyard sites. The average age of our vines is over 100 years old. The combination of biodynamic viticulture and virtually dry farming gives low yields of intense fruit which in turn are the perfect raw material for making exquisite wines. Our winemaking is truly artisanal. Two of our three vineyards and our winery are certified as biodynamic/organic by NASAA (the National Association of Sustainable Agriculture of Australia). Our wines are fruit driven, but complex, elegant, the perfect accompaniment with food, and above all outstanding value. From the outset, Maverick has been a 5 star winery in the James Halliday Australian Wine Companion, and again in the 2021 edition has received 5 red stars, with 5 wines receiving scores of 95 points and above, and three wines receiving the coveted "Best of the Best Award".







Maverick Ahrens' Creek Barossa Valley Shiraz 2017

The 18ha vineyard (with 3ha of ancestor vine shiraz) was planted in the 1870s by the Lehmann family. Hand-picked, open-fermented, matured for 22 months in French oak. The quality of the wine is awesome, its intensity, its focus and its length all of the highest quality.







Maverick Trial Hill Eden Valley Shiraz 2017

8ha organic vineyard (with 1.6ha of old vine shiraz), everything done by hand that could possibly be managed this way. The freshness of the wine is such that it might coast through 40-50 years if well stored, the Diam cork perfectly inserted. There is a shimmering red fruit heart to the wine, small black fruits and fine tannins never likely to break that line of this awesome wine.







Maverick Ahrens' Creek Barossa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2017

Hand-picked, 24 hours cold soak, small open fermenters, pressed to new French oak for 22 months, only 4 barriques made. A very high quality wine, beautiful line, length and balance.





The Maverick Barossa Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon 2017

\$320

A blend of two barriques of shiraz and one barrique of cabernet sauvignon. Small open fermenter, matured for 22 months. Delicious wine, harmonious cassis fruit, superfine tannins, balanced and long.





Maverick Trial Hill Eden Valley Grenache 2018

Eden Valley's climate is cooler compared to the Barossa Valley, delivering wines that move more fluidly and with more grace.
